

## Key Questions to consider:

<b>Charter School Governing Board</b>
How will your charter school board be involved in the decision making during site closure?
How will school board meetings be conducted? (i.e. normally scheduled meetings following E.O.)
Is your school set up with a teleconferencing number for meetings held during site closure?
<b>Communication</b>
How will the charter school communicate with staff?
How will the charter school communicate with parents and students?
How will the charter school determine student/family needs during site closure?
How will you facilitate any necessary changes to IEPs with parents? (See Distance Learning)
<b>Nutritional Services</b>
How will your students access nutritional services during site closure?
<b>Student Supervision</b>
Did your school provide student supervision (before and/or after school care) prior to school closure?
Do you plan, at any time during site closure, to provide student supervision?
If yes, what are the details of your plan? (eligibility, staffing, activities, etc.)
<b>Distance Learning</b>
What is your school's short term plan? (closed, enrichment, mandatory instruction)
What is your school's long term plan? (remain closed, enrichment, mandatory instruction)
If you plan to provide either enrichment or mandatory instruction:

<b>Technology</b>
Do students have access to the necessary technology required in your distance learning plan?
What is your school's plan to meet students' technology/internet needs throughout site closure?
